Circle Park Behavioral Health Services offers a wide range of counseling resources for individuals, families, and groups.

We recognize that addictions of all types are not a single problem with simple solutions- and affect all ages, races, socio-economic levels and educational backgrounds.

Outpatient Services

Outpatient Services provide individuals with confidential assessment, counseling sessions and referral services as needed by experienced, credentialed and licensed counselors. Counseling services are available and provided to meet flexible personal and work schedules.

Intensive Outpatient (IOP)

Intensive Outpatient Program is designed to serve as a bridge between traditional outpatient treatment and more costly and extensive inpatient care. IOP offers addictions treatment in a condensed format that can be adjusted to meet individual needs and schedules.

Alcohol Drug Safety Action Program (ADSAP)

Alcohol Drug Safety Action Program, or more commonly known as ADSAP, is an educational and treatment program for individuals convicted of DUI and/or like violations. Successful completion of the ADSAP program is a prerequisite for regaining driving privileges following a DUI or like conviction.

Child and Adolescent Services

Child and Adolescent Services provide a confidential assessment and recommend counseling resources for the individual and family that is tailored to address a variety of behaviors. Some of our area's referral sources include Florence County Schools, Department of Juvenile Justice, 12th Judicial Circuit Juvenile Drug Court and the Florence County Department of Social Services when deemed appropriate.

Offender Based Intervention (OBI)

Offender Based Intervention program provides intensive counseling resources to adults involved with the legal system due to alcohol or drug related issues.

Drug Screening Laboratory

Circle Park's on-site drug screening laboratory provides drug testing for businesses, counseling services, the judicial system, and is available to the general public.

HIV/ AIDS

Services offered include on-site rapid HIV testing, counseling, and referrals to appropriate area resources. Alcohol and other drug use remain as one of the highest risk factors for the transmission of HIV/ AIDS and our services target not only its treatment but its prevention as well by reducing risky behaviors involving alcohol and other drugs.

Chrysalis Residential Treatment Center For Women With Children

The Chrysalis Center is a unique, extended-term residential treatment facility for chemically dependent women and their young children. Designed to provide a nurturing therapeutic community, Chrysalis offers a unique opportunity for children to continue to live on-site with their mothers during the entire treatment process. This approach offers women the choice of seeking help with less fear of losing their children. Children residing at the center receive professional support and counseling while their mothers gain a new chance at life...a chance to break the cycle of addiction.

Prevention Services

Circle Park Prevention Services provides a variety of evidence-based, curriculum-driven programs to youth in school and community settings to increase their perception of risk of using alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs; as well as increasing positive decision making skills.

Parent and Child Transitions (PACT)

The Parent and Child Transitions program is an eight-hour educational program that helps parents, children and families deal with the difficult transitions that often accompany the separation and divorce process.

Rotarians in Drug Deterrence Education (RIDDE)

Rotarians in Drug Deterrence Education is a collaborative program of the Florence Rotary Clubs and Circle Park, RIDDE is an eight lesson curriculum centered on helping children develop the personal skills they need to resist the use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs, avoid violence and conflict, and make healthy lifestyle choices.

Alcohol Education Program (AEP)

Alcohol Education Program is an eight-hour educational program that teaches youth about the negative consequences of underage drinking and its potentially devastating impact on individuals and their families. The class is taught in a series of four 2-hour sessions allowing the participant's time to reflect on and process each lesson. Referrals are made to the program through the 12th Judicial Circuit Solicitor's office and are also available to any youth under the age of 21.

Tobacco Education Program (TEP)

The Tobacco Education Program is a four-hour tobacco education and awareness program targeting youth under the age of 18. The program is in response to the Underage Tobacco Act of 2006 which makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 18 to possess, purchase, or use tobacco products in South Carolina. Referrals to the program are made through the legal system and are also available to any youth in the community under the age of 18.

All- Stars /Guiding Good Choices/ Project Northland

These are three multi-session research and evidence-based programs that provide the necessary skills for its participants to address alcohol, tobacco and other drug issues as well as their related negative behavioral consequences. All-Stars and Project Northland are geared toward 12-17 year olds, and Guiding Good Choices provides parents with the skills to enhance their efforts in developing the decision-making skills of their children through their efforts at home.

Florence County Coalition for Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Prevention

The Coalition's mission is to develop and implement, through interagency and community collaboration, a comprehensive and community-based prevention strategy. The Coalition is composed of volunteers who represent Florence County's various industries, agencies, organizations and communities, supported by a professional staff employed by Circle Park. Since its inception, the Coalition has also established satellite community coalitions in the Lake City, Johnsonville and Pamplico areas to ensure that its efforts are county-wide.

The Coalition operates several task forces and initiatives such as:

Alcohol Enforcement Team (AET)

The Alcohol Enforcement Team is a multi-jurisdictional law enforcement team that actively works in the Florence and Marion Counties to reduce the use of alcohol by underage youth. This is a collaborative effort between numerous law enforcement agencies that conduct initiatives such as: compliance checks, public safety checkpoints, party patrols and saturation patrols. These evidence-based strategies have proven to be effective in reducing the use of alcohol and the sales of alcohol to minors.

Campus Safety Initiative (CSI)

The Campus Safety Initiative is a collaborative effort with Francis Marion University that focuses on the use and abuse of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs by college youth on and off campus. A variety of programs and initiatives are conducted throughout the school year to provide education and awareness to students and staff.

Palmetto Retailer's Education Program (PREP)

PREP is a course that helps reduce underage access to alcohol and tobacco products in our communities, while also lowering the liability risks for businesses and their employees. The curriculum provides managers and servers/sellers with the knowledge and skills to comply with state, community, and establishment level alcohol and tobacco policies, and to avoid the potential consequences of failing to comply with those policies.

Parenting Issues Task Force

The Parenting Issues Task Force promotes education and awareness of the issues and influences affecting youth. This task force conducts an annual parenting conference which provides parents and professionals the skills and resources necessary to address the latest challenges facing youth today.

Drug Free Communities Grant

The Drug Free Communities Grant is a ten year grant to establish a grassroots community effort in the Johnsonville and Pamplico communities to measurably reduce the influence and consequences associated with the use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.
